Introducing the Inclusive Flat Rate Office Visit

While you may find that the rate you pay for the office visit is higher than what you've paid in the past, it now includes so much more VALUE for you.

What is the Sliding Fee Discount Schedule (SFDS)?

The sliding fee discount schedule is a payment model that HSNT uses to determine patient financial contribution for services based on income and family size. The sliding fee scale discount is now a flat rate, giving you peace of mind knowing what your out of pocket costs will be at the time of your visit. [Watch Video](#)

Quality

Who should complete the SFDS paperwork?

All patients are invited to complete the SFDS paperwork. This allows the team to determine the discount that applies to your visit. If you have health insurance, you are still encouraged to apply as this might reduce any out of pocket costs as allowed by your insurance company. [Watch Video](#)

Care

How is my discount determined?

Your discount is determined by your household income and the number of people living in your household. Please provide proof of income and a list of the members in your household. The household assessment will be applied to all members of your family/household that are patients at HSNT. [Watch Video](#)

What is included in my medical visit office fee?

Lots of value! Your flat rate office visit includes your medical office visit, any labs that your provider orders during the visit, and injections with includes immunizations like the flu vaccine.

Nominal Fee- Patients below 100% of Poverty

For patients who fall at or below 100% of the federal poverty guidelines, HSNT will apply a nominal fee of \$35 which includes the office visit, labs, injectables and immunizations.

& your Family

What if my income is more than 200% of Poverty?

Great news! If your household income is above 200% of poverty, HSNT has developed a flat rate for you too! You will pay only \$170 for your office visit, labs, injectables and immunizations.
